Highlight of Field Study: Being a half-day field study, participants will be able to investigate the:
(1) landuse conflicts;
(2) controversies between development and conservation; and
(3) improvement of the environment & sustainable development in Fung Yuen (鳳園) - Sha Lo Tung (沙螺洞) - Hok Tau (鶴藪) area

Programme: 8:30 am - Coach leave Kowloon Tong for Tai Po (Place of assembly: outside KCR Kowloon Tong Station)
9:30 am - Field study: **Walking** from Fung Yuen (鳳園) (including Butterfly Park 蝴蝶保育區) → Sha Lo Tung (沙螺洞) → Hok Tau Reservoir (鶴藪水塘) → Hok Tau (鶴藪) (including Produce Green 綠田園)
3:00 pm - End of study; coach leave Hok Tau for KCR Fanling Station
